 I am a certified medical massage therapist operating in Ks.Mo and Tx (licences in all) I have several clients that i see weekly that depend on my services to keep mobile and pain free. I have been shut down since early March but some of those clients are in dire need of pain controll have a pt with severe thoracic outlet syndrome that is also a recovering opioid addict, she is 9 months clean, and before the shut down was seeing me 2x a week and making very good progress with her pain management. She is now in crisis mode because her pain has returned and all her doctors have to offer her is drugs for the pain. She has been to a chiropractor numerous times with no relief and shes worried she will have to take opioids again. Another pt is post-op from bariactric surgery and has severe lymphedema. The only way she has found relief from this condition is through lymphatic massage. There are no other options for her. I have a recovering cancer pt with the same condition. These are just a few but are some of my most severe pts. What i do is highly specialized and more like physical therapy than "massage". I think there are only a handful of truly medical massage certified therapist in the KC area. I am also a former paramedic in Texas and i am well aware of the risks and well versed in infection control. .
