PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER FOR QUARANTINE

BY THE GRANT COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER AND GRANT COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

For individuals with an exposure to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

The Grant County Health Department (GCHD) and the Grant County Health Officer have been informed that you have been exposed to a patient infectious with COVID-19 during the time period 11/29/2020. If you develop COVID-19, you could spread the virus before you develop any symptoms. The Grant County Health Officer is issuing this quarantine order in accordance with current Kansas laws and regulations and consistent with current Federal and State recommendations for the purpose of protecting the public and preventing further spread of the disease. ***You must not come in contact with anybody (including at work or in school) until the full incubation period of 14 days has passed. This order is effective immediately and remains in effect until pending.***

Terms of Quarantine

Beginning: 11/29/2020

Ending: minimum of 24 days pending course of disease of contact and when released by the Grant County Health Department

1. You are confined to your home at [REDACTED] for the duration of the quarantine period identified above.
2. You may not have visitors at your home unless authorized by GCHD.
3. GCHD will monitor your condition by please call the health department if needed
4. If you develop any symptoms of COVID-19, immediately contact GCHD at (620)356-1545. Symptoms may include the following: fever, chills, body shakes, muscle aches, malaise, headaches, sore throat, runny nose, lower respiratory illness, (cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing), nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, diarrhea (greater than 3 days without another associated cause), change or loss of smell or taste or any other changes to your health.

It is very important that you comply with this quarantine order. Your health and the health of others depends upon it. If necessary, this quarantine order may be enforced by law enforcement at the direction of the Grant County Health Officer. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-129c, you may request a hearing in Grant County District Court to contest this Order. However, such request for a hearing does not stay or enjoin this Order and you are still subject to its requirements unless and until ruled otherwise by a judge.

In the event that you are unable to provide for your own basic needs such as food, the Grant County Health Department will make arrangements with you to make sure your basic needs are met.
