AFT Kansas Condemns Hamas Attack, Stands with Israeli People

While we believe our members should be able to express their views and make associational statements as the Graduate Teaching Assistants Coalition of the University of Kansas, the AFT and AFT Kansas have positions on the Middle East conflict that differ significantly.

In the aftermath of the Hamas attack on Israel that left 1400 people murdered and the increasingly brutal humanitarian crisis in Gaza, the AFT released a statement condemning the Hamas attack and decrying the Palestinian humanitarian crisis.
